We are pleased to announce the **Call for Panels and Papers** for the **13th East Asian Conference on Slavic Eurasian Studies**. This conference will be held in Fukuoka, Japan. Fukuoka is recognized as an ideal location for this gathering due to its openness to various parts of Asia and its rich history as a key center for cultural and commercial exchange.

The East Asian Conference on Slavic Eurasian Studies is marking its thirteenth convention. It began with an agreement between the Slavic and Eurasian studies associations of China, Korea, and Japan. The event has steadily gained global recognition, now attracting increasing participation from scholars outside Asia, demonstrating how this regional event functions as a global forum for intellectual discussion. The conference also serves as a crucial place for a new generation of researchers, including graduate students, to gain experience and participate in international colloquium.

Main theme of the conference is "**The Age of Multipolarity, or the Arrival of a General Crisis.**" It reflects the current international situation, which the Organizing Committee acknowledges is not a bright one. However, researchers are tasked with confronting these harsh realities head-on and forging a path forward through mutual discussion.

Conference Scope and Topics:

We welcome submissions addressing **any topics and areas related to the Slavic-Eurasian regions**.

Submission Categories

We welcome both **Panel Proposals** and **Individual Paper Submissions**.

Panel Proposals

- A standard panel consists of **three speakers**, a **chair**, and a **discussant**.
- Applications will still be accepted if the chair and discussant are yet to be determined.
- Each panel is allotted 100 minutes, and time allocation is left to the discretion of the panel organizer. In other words, it is also possible to organize panels such as **round tables** or **book reviews**.
- Panel submissions should include the title and abstract of the group discussion, the full names of the participants, contact information, and the title and abstract of each paper **within 300 words**.

Individual Paper Submissions

- Individuals are invited to submit abstracts for research papers **within 300 words**.
